ANNAMARIA IMPAGLIAZZO was elected to the Board of Directors in 1998. She has served as a member of the Council of Auxiliaries Executive Board and as the President of the Council of Auxiliaries. Mrs. Impagliazzo has been the President of the Oceanside Auxiliary and a representative of BOCES to the NCPA Board.
